


RISK MANAGEMENT CHALLENGES

- Poor visibility of various initiatives
- Various interpretation of risk vocabulary varies
- Anomalies in risk acceptance criteria Joint Venture entities and Geographies
- Personnel competency
- Normalization of deviation too close to identify risks!

- Dashboard visibility
- Tolerable risk acceptance
- Project prioritization and capital allocation
- Upkeeping of adequate controls Business Assurance
- Plant uptime and business continuity



IMPLEMENTATION CHALLENGES

- Leadership awareness
- Process Safety Risk not fully embedded in Enterprise Risk
 Management
 Focus and audiones on risk is at different levels)

- Fragmented organization structures
- Lack of competent personnel too close to processes to realize risk
- Inadequate software tools across organization less visibility




CASE STUDY

- Compliance based work culture (Tick box mentality)
- Working in silos and fragmented organization
- Training and competency issues



HOW DID WE DO IT?





LESSONS LEARNED

- Top down approach on risk is very effective
- Central risk review authority helps visualize the risk across organization
- Enterprise risk and operational risk need to be embedded into one entity
- Training, competency and detailed vocabulary helps for unified risk ranking
- Local language translation (Russian) in this case helped
- Software tool like DNV Synergi Risk helped to raise risk visibility
